POLICY FOR GIVING

Our meeting will continue to give to national Quaker organizations to include, but not necessarily limited to AFSC, FCNL, and FWCC. (FGC?)

We will also contribute to the needs of the homeless and underserved; local religious coalitions; efforts to sustain local rural ~~structures~~ and farming; local expressions of our Peace Testimony; and our Tibetan refugee as he expresses needs.

Community structures

As other grassroots needs arise, Friends are encouraged to bring them, with supportive data, to Meeting for Worship for Business. Normally, these will be one-time donations unless further contact indicates continuing need we feel we can support.

Additionally, we will establish reserve funds for Sufferings; we will establish a Scholarship fund, to be augmented yearly, to help make worthy educational and service experiences available to our meeting.

We will allot \$200 yearly to emergencies, received by the Resident and discussed with the Clerk. We suggest a \$35- \$50 limit for each one.
